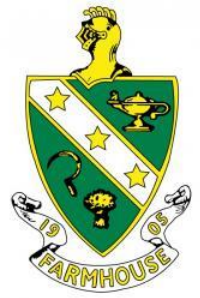




FarmHouse Fraternity Incoming Students' Scholarship
